Focus is on individual and family healing and long-term recovery.

The NYC ARISE Training will take place over a three-day period, hosted & co-sponsored by the **Caron Treatment Center** in NYC (www.Caron.org), and co-sponsored by **Willingway Hospital** (www.Willingway.com). The event is scheduled each day from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm. A light continental breakfast with coffee and teas will be provided. Day 1: July 13

Theoretical background and overview of Intervention Models. Addiction and the brain. Overview and outcome data of the ARISE Intervention Model and Level 1, the "First Call." Didactic, interactive role-playing.

Day 2: July 14

Introduction to Transitional Family Theory, Family Motivation to Change, Genograms, and Level 1, the "First Meeting." Level 2, "Strength in Numbers" and Intervention Network meetings. Didactic, interactive role-playing.

Day 3: July 15

Level 3 - the Formal ARISE Intervention. Discussion of the Person of the Interventionist. Ethical and safety considerations. Implementation in trainee settings. Marketing strategies and materials. Didactic, interactive role-playing, and discussion time.
